Notes from the School Nurse

If your student becomes ill during the school day, the following general guidelines will be used by school staff to determine if student should be sent home:

MIDDLE SCHOOL Scheduling Update for 2023/2024

- Fever of 100 Degrees F or greater
- Vomiting or diarrhea
- contagious illness such as chickenpox, strep throat impetigo, scabies, etc.
- undiagnosed rash
- injury/accident requiring care of parent/guardian
- General discomfort such that the student cannot participate in class
- Other concerns determined by the school staff. Please keep your student home if they are sick!
